## **BSPA PASSPORT APPLICATION- NOTES:**

**Data Protection issues(abbreviated statement):-** Details of all horses issued with a BSPA Passport or Registered with us have their ownership and keeper details sent to the NATIONAL EQUINE DATABASE (NED) on a monthly basis as part of our duties as a PIO. This is done either electronically or by secure download, our data therefore contributes to the NED central database with verified breeding and Studbook details. A full version of our Data Protection & membership confidentiality statement is available online in BSPA Briefing note 1.

**BSPA PASSPORTS ARE AVAILABLE AS FOLLOWS:** (All BSPA Passports comply with EU Commission decision 92/353/EEC and Commission Regulation (EC) No 50A/2008 & 90/427 EU).

- **1-Basic Identity – (RBID)** This Passport is a document of Equine Identity only. It is not a Breeding Document nor does it register the equine to compete under BSPA rules. It can therefore be issued to any colour of Equine or indeed any species defined as “Equadie” within the legislation. Any older skewbald/piebald “Un-Licensed and Un-Graded Stallion will be issued with a RBID Passport until such time as they Grade with the BSPA. Skewbald/Piebald equines with a RBID Passport are not registered to show under BSPA rules. This may be done at a later date by payment of the required fee and the issuing of a “Registration card”. **No prefix can be applied.**
- **2-Unverified Breeding Identity & BSPA Registration Passport (UVB) –**  
Like the RBID passport, above this is an “Identity Passport” not a breeding document, but it includes a Horse or Pony Registration allowing the horse/pony to compete under BSPA rules. Breeding can be established via DNA Testing for an additional fee but does not enter the equine into the BSPA Studbook. **No prefix can be applied.**
- **3- Verified Breeding Identity Passport-** Where a covering certificate has been issued by another Breed Society or a DNA profile to either sire or dam has been submitted; OR the equine is a gelding (non breeding animal); then a 2 generation pedigree is reproduced in the passport. This does not enter the equine into the BSPA Studbook.  
**A Prefix can be used**
- **4- Full Studbook Passport-** Available to all the Progeny of BSPA Graded Stallions (BSPA Covering Certificate Must be sent) and BSPA Graded Mares with a Breed Society Covering certificate. A full 4 generation pedigree (if established) will be reproduced. Verification is required via the submission of a Certificate of origin or a breeding printout or copy of relevant passport if not a BSPA Stallion. **These MUST be sent with this form.** **A Prefix can be used**
- **5- Horse Registration –** The BSPA Register horses issued with another societies Passport which **MUST** be sent with the application form. Registration is for the life of the equine and a stamp is placed in the other PIO's Passport. Please use the specific form for this purpose.
- **Prefix Use-** All Prefixes **MUST** be registered with the Central Prefix Register and extended to BSPA. Refer [www.centralprefix@aol.com](http://www.centralprefix@aol.com) for rules and application forms. You cannot use a prefix on stock you have not bred. Annual Commercial prefixes are allowed by BSPA for showing purposes only on payment of £100 annually.
- **Photographs:** Photographs are scanned into the passport. Please send 2 in hand, side on photographs (without tack) approx 6x4 and write the name of the animal on the reverse.
- **ALL sections of this form must be completed in full and all the requested supporting documentation and Photographs sent in with it.**

- From 01/07/2009 the BSPA require that the Micro-chip barcode is included in all passport applications so that it can be inserted into the passport by us.
- Please note that if forms are incorrectly or only partially completed then the BSPA reserve the right to request an additional admin fee (£10). Under these circumstances the paperwork will be returned and any additional fee will be required to be paid prior to the completion of the passport.
- Section 1 Part B Outline diagram (sketch sheet) MUST accompany ALL passport applications.
