BSPA PASSPORT APPLICATION- NOTES: 2020

All BSPA Passports are issued under Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/262 and information processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and GDPR 2018. As regards to methods for the identification of Equidae (Equine Passport Regulations).

Please also refer to BSPA information sheet 1 for full data protection GDPR details.

BSPA PASSPORTS ARE AVAILABLE AS FOLLOWS:

Breeding & Production Equine's (refer EU/DEFRA Definitions).

- **1-Basic Identity- ID Only:** This Passport is a document of Equine Identity only. It is not a Breeding Document nor does it register the equine to compete under BSPA rules. It can therefore be issued to any colour of Equine or indeed any species defined as "Equidae" within the legislation.
- Any older Skewbald/Piebald "Un-Licensed and Un-Graded Stallion will be issued with an ID Passport until such time as they Grade with the BSPA. Equines can also "Upgrade" their status at a later stage via Youngstock Evaluation and Stallion or Mare Grading at which time they become "Registered" Equines within current Passport regulations.
No prefix can be applied.

Registered Equines: (refer EU/ DEFRA Definitions).

- **2- Verified Breeding-** Where a covering certificate has been issued by another Breed Society or a DNA profile to either sire or dam has been submitted; OR the equine is a gelding (non breeding animal); then a 2 Generation pedigree is reproduced in the passport. This does not enter the equine into the BSPA Studbook.
A Prefix can be used either extended to BSPA for use or Reserved with CPR.

3- Full Studbook Passport- Available to all the Progeny of BSPA Graded Stallions (BSPA Covering Certificate Must be sent) and BSPA Graded Mares with a Breed Society Covering certificate. A full 4 generation pedigree (if established) will be reproduced. Verification is required via the submission of a Certificate of origin or a breeding printout or copy of relevant passport if not a BSPA Stallion. **These MUST be sent with this form. A Breeders Prefix can be used either extended to BSPA for use or Reserved with CPR.**

- **Prefix Use-** All Prefixes MUST be registered with the Central Prefix Register and extended to BSPA. Refer www.centralprefix@aol.com for rules and application forms. You cannot use a prefix on stock you have not bred. Annual Commercial prefixes are allowed by BSPA for showing purposes only on payment of £100 annually.
- **Photographs:** Photographs are kept for BSPA records and scanned into the passport. Please send 2 in hand, side on photographs (without tack) approx. 6x4 and write the name of the animal on the reverse.
- **ALL sections of this form must be completed in full and all the requested supporting documentation and Photographs sent in with it.**
- **ALL PASSPORT APPLICATIONS MUST have the Micro-chip barcode included in order for them to be inserted into the passport and heat sealed. IF A VET HAS HANDWRITTEN A PRE EXISTING CHIP NUMBER THEN THEY MUST SIGN THAT SECTION OF THE FORM & SKETCH.**
- Please note that if forms are incorrectly or only partially completed then the BSPA reserve the right to request an additional admin fee (£10). Under these circumstances the paperwork will be returned and any additional fee will be required to be paid prior to the completion of the passport.
- Section 1 Part B Outline diagram (sketch sheet) MUST accompany ALL passport applications. **Available in downloads.**

FEE's as 01/01/2020: (many fees are avoidable if deadlines are met).

ID Only @ £30 (any colour) or £35 with Showing Registration included. Verified Breeding (not Studbook) + BSPA Showing Registration @ £45: Studbook Registration @ £60.

Non Member Fee adds £25 to each cost.

DNA Parentage Testing adds £50 to each passport in addition to ALL other costs.

LATE APPLICATION (after 20/11 of year of birth) adds (£20 to the basic cost, but is an **avoidable surcharge**. Includes BSPA Showing Registration
