Class 8Q	SPORTS HORSE /PONY Inhand Sportshorse or Sportspony any age Filly,colt, mare, gelding or stallion (Stallions must be licensed and graded with BSPA
Class 9Q	BEST MALE. Any height age or type. (Stallion rules apply)
Class 10Q	BEST FEMALE. Any height age or type.
Class 11Q	HOME PRODUCED IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER horse or pony Any age. This class is open horses and ponies that have been stabled at home since 1 st January 2022 (with no paid assistance) or kept at livery on a DIY basis (not with a show producer/trainer). Horses or ponies may not have been trained professionally. Horse/ponies entered in this class must be owned, produced, ridden or led by the owner/spouse/partner or his/her son/daughter/grandchild, who for showing purposes has not engaged in earning income from equestrian activities of any kind. Two highest placed BSPA members to qualify.
Class 12Q	PONY PLAITED not exceeding 153cms any age. (Stallion Rules apply)
Class 13Q NEW	AMATEUR INHAND CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER. Horse or pony any age, height or type. Qualification cards to be carried into the ring. Open to members and non-members two highest placed BSPA members to qualify. Amateur criteria he/she during the current or previous season; Engage in breeding, livery,buying,selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. Must not have received remuneration in connection with horses in racing,showing,livery stable or riding school this will include vets and farriers and associated equine businesses. No horse or pony may be sponsored or shall the owner or his/her immediate family accept livery or training charges. Please see BSPA Rule book.

BLUE PREFERRED – FOR THOSE SCORING 65% - 70%

WHITE CERTIFIED – FOR THOSE SCORING 65% OR LESS

Section A Skewbald and Piebald plaited Horse. Exhibits exceeding or calculated to exceed 153cm at maturity. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old, three year old. Colts and Fillies only.

Section B Skewbald and Piebald Native/Traditional/Cob. Exhibits exceeding 153cm or calculated to exceed 153cm at maturity. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old, three year old. Colts and Fillies only.

Section C Skewbald and Piebald plaited pony not exceeding 153cm. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old, three year old. Colts and Fillies only

Section D Skewbald and Piebald Native/Traditional/Cob not to exceed 153cm at maturity. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old, three year old. Colts and Fillies only

RULES

Classes will be Judged within the rules and criteria of the BSPA, copies can be obtained from them. Please note that you do not have to be a member to compete but you must hold a current membership/horse registration to qualify for the Summer Championships. The BSPA Rule Book can be downloaded from www.bsponline.com

1st – 3rd or three highest placed in open classes to qualify.

All Qualification cards MUST be signed in the ring by the class judge in order to be valid.

THE FOLLOWING CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE ONLY OPEN TO BSPA 2023 MEMBERS WITH BSPA REGISTERED HORSES AND PONIES

AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP – All highest placed Amateurs will qualify for the BSPA Indian Trail Amateur Championship. The final to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 24TH September 2023 at Onley EC .

(BSPA Membership /Amateur cards must be carried into the ring)

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP – All highest placed Juniors will qualify for the BSPA Colosso Junior Championship. The final to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 24th September at Onley EC. (Junior membership cards must be carried into the ring)

HOME PRODUCED CHAMPIONSHIP – First and Second in the Home Produced classes inhand and ridden will qualify for the Sizmer Home Produced Championship. The Final to be held AT BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 24TH September 2023 Onley EC

BSPA Skewbald and Piebald Sports Horse and Pony In Hand National Championship Qualifier. These classes are for athletic Horses and Ponies that have the conformation and movement to compete in Dressage, Show jumping or Eventing and that have a **verified/proven parentage passport, breeding must be indicated on the entry form.** The three highest places in each class to qualify for the final to be held at the British Skewbald and Piebald Association World Championships of Colour 24TH September 2023. Each Horse/Pony is to be judged individually on a triangle and also walked and trotted round the ring as a class. Marks will be awarded for confirmation, walk, trot and overall impression. **Handlers, Owners and Horses/Ponies must be members of the BSPA for qualification to remain valid.**

Classes 20-26 These classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show at Hickstead on Tuesday 25th July 2023. These classes will be judged under BSPA rules, copies of which can be downloaded from www.bsponline.com . All horses/ponies must be registered with and owners & riders members of BSPA prior to the show. Rider age is taken as 1st Jan. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA and wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class. **Membership and Qualification cards MUST be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection and signature. Failure to do so will disqualify any competitor and their qualification handed down to the next unqualified competitor.** Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cms or under must possess a current JMB height certificate in order to compete at RIHS. Qualification: 1st place and the highest next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place.

1. The BSPA is not responsible for any accident, damage, loss or injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever.
2. The judge's decision is FINAL.
3. No entries to be refunded.
4. No lunging in the collecting ring.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without explanation.
6. Any horse, pony, handler or rider behaving in any way that poses a risk to itself or others will be asked to leave.
7. All colts/stallions must be bitted. NO EXCEPTIONS, STALLIONS 4 YEARS AND OVER MUST BE GRADED WITH BSPA AND WEAR ABSPA STALLION 2023 ID DISC.
8. Horses/ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years old and over unless otherwise stated in the schedule
9. Horse/ponies ages are from 1st January 2023
- 10. ALL RIDERS WHEN MOUNTED MUST WEAR CORRECTLY SECURED BRITISH STANDARD RIDING HATS. WITH 3-POINT PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WHICH COMPLIES WITH THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA THAT CAN BE FOUND IN THE BSPA RULE BOOK PAGE 13 RULE 4 AND APPLIES TO RIDERS OF ALL AGES. IN SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIPS ONLY, TOP HATS/BOWLERS/BEAGLERS MAY BE WORN BY RIDERS OVER 18 YEARS. (PLEASE CHECK FOR CHANGES WITH SHOW SECRETARY ON THE DAY.)**
- 11. (JUNIORS 18 YEARS AND UNDER WEAR HATS WITH CHIN STRAPS IN ALL RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIPS).The new European standard will be allowed once finalised and will be advised in due course. Please see current rules from www.showingcouncil.com**
12. All colts/stallions aged 4yrs and over must be licensed or graded with the BSPA to go in showing classes. No rider or handler under 14yrs may exhibit a colt or stallion.
13. ALL STALLIONS MUST AND WEAR A BSPA GRADED STALLION ID DISC 2023 WHEN COMPETING. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL MEAN DISQUALIFICATION.
14. **STALLION DISCS FROM OTHER SOCIETIES MAY NOT BE WORN.**
15. Owners/Handlers/Riders/Horses must be 2023 members/registered with BSPA to qualify
16. Spurs must not be worn in any Ridden Pony class.
17. Dressage whips are forbidden, and all whips must be under 30 inches
18. No mucking out into the car park
19. No smoking in arena
20. No dogs except in horsebox area, MUST be kept on leads at all times. Some showgrounds prohibit dogs from attending, check showground rules.
- 21. Mobile phones must be turned off in the ring**
22. No earrings, tongue studs, or any jewellery may be worn whilst competing
- 23. Grooms attending competitors in the ring MUST be correctly turned out, NO JEANS or leisure wear is permitted. Grooms may refused entry to the ring if incorrectly dressed. See BSPA rule book page 22, sections 68-69.**
24. The BSPA is very keen on upholding animal welfare for all equines, or any animal attending BSPA shows. Anyone considered to be breaching BSPA animal welfare guidelines, they will be asked to leave the showground.
