BLUE PREFERRED – FOR THOSE SCORING 65% - 70%

WHITE CERTIFIED – FOR THOSE SCORING 65% OR LESS

<u>Section A</u> Skewbald and Piebald plaited Horse. Exhibits exceeding or calculated to exceed 153cm at maturity. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old & three year old. Colts and Fillies only.

<u>Section B</u> Skewbald and Piebald Native/Traditional/Cob. Exhibits exceeding 153cm or calculated to exceed 153cm at maturity. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old & three year old. Colts and Fillies only.

<u>Section C</u> Skewbald and Piebald plaited pony not exceeding 153cm. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old & three year old. Colts and Fillies only

<u>Section D</u> Skewbald and Piebald Native/Traditional/Cob not to exceed 153cm at maturity. To be Judged in three categories yearling, two year old & three year old. Colts and Fillies only

SHOW RULES

Classes will be Judged within the rules and criteria of the B.S.P.A, copies can be obtained from them. Please note that you do not have to be a member to compete but you must hold a current membership/horse registration to qualify for the Summer Championships. Rule Book can be downloaded from www.bspaonline.com $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ or three highest placed in open classes to qualify.

All Qualification cards MUST be signed in the ring by the class judge in order to be valid.

THE FOLLOWING CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE ONLY OPEN TO BSPA 2024 MEMBERS WITH BSPA REGISTERED HORSES AND PONIES

AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP – 2 highest placed Amateurs will qualify for the BSPA Amateur Championships. The final to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2024.

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP – All highest placed Juniors will qualify for the BSPA Junior Championship. The final to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2024. (Junior membership cards must be carried into the ring) HOME PRODUCED CHAMPIONSHIP –2 Highest placed Home Produced will qualify for the Home - Produced Championships. The Final to be held AT BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2024.

Class 8 The Skewbald and Piebald Sports Horse and Pony In Hand. National Championship Qualifier.

These classes are for athletic Horses and Ponies that have the conformation and movement to compete in Dressage, Show jumping or Eventing and that have a verified/proven parentage passport, breeding must be indicated on the entry form. The three highest places in each class to qualify for the final to be held at the British Skewbald and Piebald Association World Championships of Colour8-9th May 2024. Each Horse/Pony is to be judged individually on a triangle and also walked and trotted round the ring as a class. Marks will be awarded for confirmation, walk, trot and overall impression. Handlers, Owners and Horses/Ponies must be members of the BSPA for qualification to remain valid.

Classes 20-26 These classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead Tuesday 23th July 2024. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules. Download from www.bspaonline.com all horses/ponies must be registered and all owners and riders BSPA members prior to the show. Rider age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate. Competitors qualifying at this show for The Royal International Horse Show 23th-28th July 2024 must submit their entries by recorded delivery post with full payment within 48hours of qualifying to The Showing Secretary, All England Jumping Course, Hickstead, West Sussex RH17 5NU. Schedules and entry forms can be downloaded at

http://www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-and-results/the-longgines-royal-international-horse-show/ All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA for 2024 and must wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class.

No competitor/owner/horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2024 membership of BSPA, and a RIHS qualification card. Memberships/ horse registrations must be in place before you enter classes. Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place.

Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class qualify for Amateur And Junior Supreme Championship Finals to be held at BSPA World Of Colour Championship Show September 2024.. Cards to be shown and qualification card signed. All Champion and Reserve Champion winners qualify for the BSPA Star Championship at WCC.

All horses/ponies must be registered with BSPA all owners/riders members of BSPA prior to entry and membership + qualification cards must be carried into the ring and signed at the time of qualification in the ring by the Judge. Failure to comply with this rule will mean disqualification."

RULES CONTINUED:

- 1. The judge's decision is FINAL.
- 2. No entries will be refunded.
- 3. No lunging in the collecting ring.
- 4. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without explanation.
- 5. Any horse, pony, handler or rider behaving in any way that poses a risk to itself or others will be asked to leave.
- 6. All colts/stallions must be bitted. No exceptions.
- 7. Stallions 4 years and over must be licensed & graded with BSPA and wear a 2024 BSPA Stallion ID disc. When competing. Failure to comply will mean disqualification.
- 8. Discs from other societies or self-produced disks **must not** be worn at any time.

Failure to comply will mean disqualification.

- 9. No rider or handler under 14yrs may exhibit a colt/stallion.
- 10. Horses/ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years old and over unless otherwise stated in the schedule
- 11. Horse/ponies ages are from 1 January 2024
- 12. All riders when mounted must wear correctly secured British standard riding hats with 3-point protective headgear complying with one of the following:-
 - PAS 015, VG1, (BS)EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a ONWARDS, SNELL E2001, SNELLE2016, AS/NZS 3838 2003, ONWARDS. IN SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIPS ONLY, TOP HATS/BOWLERS/BEAGLERS MAY BE WORN BY RIDERS OVER 18 YEARS (JUNIORS 18 YEARS AND UNDER AS 01/01/2024 WEAR HATS WITH CHIN STRAPS IN ALL RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIPS).
- 13. Owners/Handlers/Riders/Horses must be members/registered with B.S.P.A in order to qualify
- 14. Spurs must not be worn in any Ridden Pony class.
- 15. Dressage whips are forbidden and all whips must be under 30 inches
- 16. No mucking out into the car park
- 17. No smoking OR vaping in the arena
- 18. No dogs except in horsebox area
- 19. Mobile phones must be turned off in the ring
- 20. No earrings, tongue studs, or any jewellery may be worn whilst competing

BSPA AMATEUR AND HOME-PRODUCED STATUS.

- CLASSES 13 and 14- "A person is an amateur for the purposes of showing under BSPA Rules if they DO NOT derive any income from working with equines, either as self-employed or as an employee during the current or previous year. OR engage in breeding, livery, dealing, buying or selling in a commercial capacity, OR receive renumeration for employment in connection with horses in racing, showing livery, or in a riding school. OR show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. OR act as a 'brand ambassador'. OR the equine is stabled in a professional show producers' yard during the current season."
- ➤ CLASSES 13 and 14- "Members are eligible to enter BSPA home produced classes if they conform the amateur definition (above) AND their equine have been continuously stabled at home or in a DIY capacity at premises not run by a professional producer or trainer. All equines must be owned, produced and ridden by their recorded owner, partner, spouse or child. Riders/Handlers must not have shown any equine produced by a professional producer/trainer/groom at any show from the 1st January of the current season, NOR may any equine be shown by a rider/handler who has shown by a professional producer/trainer/groom since January 1st of the current season.
- "THE BSPA EXPECTS ALL COMPETITORS TO RESPECT THE SPIRIT OF THESE CLASSES. On the day of competition in any amateur or Home- produced class, no professional producer may ride or 'work in' the relevant equine. Nor are they allowed into the ring to groom or strip.
 - A professional show producer in this context, is a person who derives income from keeping, training, horses and ponies and/or their riders for the show ring. This need not be their sole or main source of income.
