THE BSPA JUNIOR RIDER AND AMATEUR / AMATEUR HOME PRODUCED IN HAND AND RIDDEN INAGURAL 'AWARD OF MERIT' WILL BE PRESENTED AT THIS SHOW.

SHOW RULES:

Classes will be Judged within the rules and criteria of the B.S.P.A, copies can be obtained from them. Please note that you do not have to be a member to compete but you must hold a current membership/horse registration to qualify for the Summer Championships.

ONLY BSPA MEMBERS CAN QUALIFY

Class 6- BSPA Style & Performance. Competitors will enter the ring individually and will be judged on the turnout of horse/pony & rider. To be followed by a short show not to exceed 1.1/2 minutes. The show must include the following set movements which can be performed in any order. TROT & CANTER ON BOTH REINS. A 3 LOOPED SERPENTINE AT TROT. WALK ON A LONG REIN. REIN BACK A MINIMUM OF 4 STEPS. HALT IMMOBILITRY.

Marks awarded Maximum 100 as follows:

STYLE - incl. the Turnout of Mount @ 50 marks. NB the Horse/Pony should be turned out appropriately for the type of animal that is being shown. PERFORMANCE @ 50 marks Points will be deducted for any omitted set movements.

Classes 7-14 These classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead Tuesday 21st July 2026. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules. Download from www.bspaonline.com all horses/ponies must be registered and all owners and riders BSPA members prior to the show. Rider age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate.

All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA for 2025 and must wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class.

No competitor/owner/horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2025 membership of BSPA, and a RIHS qualification card. Memberships/ horse registrations must be in place before you enter classes.

Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place.

All horses/ponies must be registered with BSPA all owners/ riders' members of BSPA prior to entry and membership + qualification cards must be carried into the ring and signed at the time of qualification in the ring by the Judge. Failure to comply with this rule will mean disqualification."

Class 22 The Skewbald and Piebald Sports Horse and Pony In Hand.

These classes are for athletic Horses and Ponies that have the conformation and movement to compete in Dressage, Show jumping or Eventing and that have a verified/proven parentage passport, breeding must be indicated on the entry form. Competitors need not be members of BSPA in order to compete, but their horse/pony MUST be Registered with BSPA.

Each Horse/Pony is to be judged individually on a triangle and also walked and trotted round the ring as a class. Marks will be awarded for confirmation, walk, trot and overall impression.

BSPA AMATEUR AND AMATEUR HOME-PRODUCED STATUS.

- * "A person is an amateur for the purposes of showing under BSPA Rules if they DO NOT derive any income from working with equines, either as self-employed or as an employee during the current or previous year. OR engage in breeding, livery, dealing, buying or selling in a commercial capacity, OR receive renumeration for employment in connection with horses in racing, showing livery, or in a riding school. OR show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. OR act as a 'brand ambassador'. OR the equine is stabled in a professional show producers' yard during the current season."
- A person is eligible to enter BSPA Amateur home-produced classes if they conform the amateur definition (above) AND their equine has been continuously stabled at home or in a DIY capacity at premises not run by a professional producer or trainer. All equines must be owned, produced and ridden by their recorded owner, partner, spouse or child. Riders/Handlers must not have shown any equine produced by a professional producer/trainer/groom at any show from the 1st January of the current season, NOR may any equine be shown by a rider/handler who has shown by a professional producer/trainer/groom since January 1st of the current season.
- "THE BSPA EXPECTS ALL COMPETITORS TO RESPECT THE SPIRIT OF THESE CLASSES. On the day of competition in any amateur or Home- produced class, no professional producer may ride or 'work in' the relevant equine. Nor are they allowed into the ring to groom or strip.
 - A professional show producer in this context, is a person who derives income from keeping, training, horses and ponies and/or their riders for the show ring. This need not be their sole or main source of income.

SHOW RULES CONTINUED:

BSPA Rule Book can be downloaded from www.bspaonline.com $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ or three highest placed in open classes WILL Qualify for WCC. All Qualification cards MUST be signed in the ring by the class judge in order to be valid.

- 1. The judge's decision is FINAL.
- 2. No entries will be refunded.
- 3. No lunging in the collecting ring.
- 4. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without explanation.
- 5. Any horse, pony, handler or rider behaving in any way that poses a risk to itself or others will be asked to leave.
- 6. All colts/stallions must be bitted. No exceptions.
- 7. Stallions 4 years and over must be licensed & graded with BSPA and wear a 2025 BSPA Stallion ID disc. When competing. Failure to comply will mean disqualification.
- 8. Discs from other societies or self-produced disks must not be worn at any time.

Failure to comply will mean disqualification.

- 9. No rider or handler under 14yrs may exhibit a colt/stallion.
- 10. Horses/ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years old and over unless otherwise stated in the schedule
- 11. Horse/ponies ages are from 1 January 2025
- 12. All riders when mounted must wear correctly secured British standard riding hats with 3-point protective headgear complying with one of the following: -

PAS 015, VG1, (BS)EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a ONWARDS, SNELL E2001, SNELLE2016, AS/NZS 3838 2003, ONWARDS. IN SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIPS ONLY, TOP HATS/BOWLERS/BEAGLERS MAY BE WORN BY RIDERS OVER 18 YEARS (JUNIORS 18 YEARS AND UNDER AS 01/01/2025 WEAR HATS WITH CHIN STRAPS IN ALL RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIPS).

- 13. Owners/Handlers/Riders/Horses must be members/registered with B.S.P.A in order to qualify
- 14. Spurs must not be worn in any Ridden Pony class.
- 15. Dressage whips are forbidden and all whips must be under 30 inches
- 16. No mucking out into the car park
- 17. No smoking OR vaping in the arena
- 18. No dogs except in horsebox area
- 19. Mobile phones must be turned off in the ring
- 20. No earrings, tongue studs, or any jewellery may be worn whilst competing
- 21. No photography of any competitor (other than the Official Photographer) is permitted without the permission of BSPA.
